Viet Nam attends Asia-Europe environment forum

Seoul, Mar. 26 (VNA) - Viet Nam was among the participants in the two-day Asia-Europe Environment Forum (ASEF) that opened in Cheju, the Republic of Korea, on Thursday.

The forum, which drew environmentalists, researchers, scholars, government officials and social activists from Denmark, France, Indonesia, Japan, Singapore and Viet Nam, aimed to boost cooperation on climate changes between the two continents.

Another forum on an effective international mechanism to build principles and policies relating to environmental protection will be held from Mar. 29-31. The forum will also discuss measures to deal with climate change.

Participants will consider the Kyoto protocol's effects on Asia-Europe environment cooperation and discuss measures to enhance the implementation of the clean development mechanism.--Enditem
