Asia-Europe Forum for Young Photographers 2004 ended in Hanoi

In a series of cultural activities towards ASEM 5 Summit to take place in Hanoi next Oct., the third Asia-Europe Forum for Young Photographers 2004 was ended July 10th with the participants of 20 international photographers. All these artists have their own views of the life of Hanoians as well as the urbanization process of the city.

Naho Kudo, an artist from Japan came to Vietnam for the first time. She desired to take arial pictures of Hanoi capital city. Naho Kudo has taken many pictures in Hang Be street where she thought is the centre of Hanoi's ancient quarter. Hanoi in her pictures looks so peaceful, tender and green.

Naho Kudo, Japanese Artist said: *"I love Hanoi due its hamonious combination between traditional and modern characters. In an ancient street, we can see a moss-covered wall but also an Internet Cafe, Bar or Karaoke. The urbanization process has not been so strong. So with me, Hanoi is very lovely"*.

For Anh Tuan, a photographer of VNexpress online-newspaper, knowledge got from the Forum has helped him much in taking special pictures on Trang Tien Street.

Anh Tuan, Photographer, VN Express told: *"Previously, we often photographed the bookstores, book sellers or buyers. But now, I think I will take pictures of other people on the street such as street children or beggars"*.

20 international photographers from 19 different countries have come to Hanoi to make photo reports on the city's urbanization process as well as the peaceful life of Hanoians. These photos have warned people the dangers of the urbanization with people and the city. Hanoi also appeared so lively, peaceful and beautiful through the eyes of these foreign artists./.
