



e-Learning Booms in Korea

A series of international conferences and events for e-Learning is currently taking place in Korea.

The Asia-Europe Foundation, Korea National Open University and the Ministry of Education and Human Resources Development are co-hosting the "Asia-Europe Colloquy on University Cooperation" from Sept. 25-27. During the conference, some 100 educational experts from countries in Asia and Europe are scheduled to discuss issues regarding e-Learning.

Tomorrow, the ministry will also hold an international seminar under the theme, "Sharing Vision for Innovative Education." Educators from 20 countries, including developed countries such as Australia, Japan and the U.S., will gather and share ideas about e-learning education in the seminar.

e-Learning is education through networked technology, such as the Internet and intranet. It enables people to learn without limiting them to a particular time or place.

The ministry expects to boost public education and reduce private education costs by providing a varied and high-quality selection of e-learning programs.
