Programme

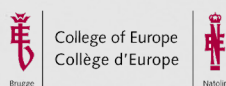


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The ASEFYLS Navigators Training consists of 4 main elements: 2 trainings, in India and Poland respectively, participation as a resource person at the 3rd ASEF Young Leaders Summit (ASEFYLS3) in Brussels, Belgium, and engagement during the post-ASEFYLS3 spin-off activities phase.

The first component in the programme is a 3-day training in Pune, India. This initial step serves as a springboard to the theme of “Ethical Leadership”. Through dialogues, workshops and study visits, the programme aims to hone a nuanced and colourful understanding of leadership; navigating through personal, team and larger societal decision-making contexts. The programme goes under the mantra of: ethical leadership is not a theory, it is visible in practice and action.
